Summary: Bridger Jack campground has become the primary overnight camping location for climbers in Indian Creek and our impact has necessitated the installation of a toilet to serve the Campground.. Increasing numbers of climbers both camping and climbing on day-trips use the few toilets at Indian Creek a great deal. In order to work with the BLM on management issues at Indian Creek, the non-profit group Friends of Indian Creek is supporting the purchase of a 2-seat composting toilet specifically for the Bridger Jack campground. The BLM has already supported a permanent toilet facility that is *heavily* used by climbers; now we can help secure a free camping area by funding this composting toilet in the campground used almost exclusively by climbers. The Friends of Indian Creek has raised over \$6000 in donations and grants for the purchase of a new composting toilet.. More funds are needed for the purchase of this new toilet, and your donation will go directly toward the purchase and installation.
